The player explained that she didn't want to commit any offence.

The player explained that in Turkey, the referees act a bit differently.

She explained that she just wanted to get the ball and play.

She also explained that the situation was a bit confused due to two consecutive injuries happening just before the offence.

The player does understand the sanction and does not contest the red card.

The team's managers explained that in Turkey, underage rugby for girls is just starting. The girls lack of experience. It is their first international tournament.

The team's manager explained that the player felt very sorry and cried after getting ordered off.
